Requirements to Participate in Tropi-Dry as a Full Member

Groups and Individual Researchers Guidelines

Requirements for groups and organizations:

1. Funding is not provided to new members, but they may be integrated into future granting opportunities.
2. We will primarily admit groups that can fill a geographic gap current absent in Tropi-Dry (Areas outside of Mexico, Costa Rica, Venezuela and Brazil).
3. Organizations must be prepared to implement all Tropi-Dry protocols. These protocols will be provided for review upon request for revision.
4. Organizations must submit with their request for membership letter, a list of all personnel to be involved in the project. Emphasis must be on presenting all individuals that will contribute to Tropi-Dry's main three research areas: Ecology, Remote Sensing and Social Sciences.
5. Organizations must agree and sign Tropi-Dry's data sharing agreement.
6. Organizations must agree and sign the Margarita Declaration.
7. All documents must be submitted via email to the Tropi-Dry's secretariat: tropidry@ualberta.ca

Requirements for individual researchers:

1. Two letters are requested by the researcher:
 - a. Letter of request submitted to the country coordinator with a brief description of the project objectives and deliverables. All projects must follow Tropi-Dry protocols.
 - b. Letter of support from country leader to the Secretariat.
2. Individual researchers will be requirement is to sign Tropi-Dry's data sharing agreement
3. Individual researchers must endorse the Margarita Declaration.
